PCAK Programs:

- ▶ **F.A.C.T. (Fathers and Children Together):** This program in collaboration with Blackburn Correctional Complex and Kentucky State Reformatory helps incarcerated fathers become responsible parents upon their release from Kentucky penal institutions.
- ▶ **C.A.R.E. (Child Abuse Recognition Education):** PCAK partners with the Department for Community Based Services to provide child abuse recognition trainings, protocol and practice to medical professionals across the state.
- ▶ **Kids Are Worth It! Conference:** Kentucky's only multi-disciplinary child abuse prevention conference offered in the state.
- ▶ **1-800-CHILDREN:** Toll-free, statewide, 24 hour/7 day a week parent resource and referral help line-offering parents and caregivers a life line of support. During the 2008-2009 Fiscal Year, PCAK assisted 1,717 families with support and/or referrals on 1-800-CHILDREN.

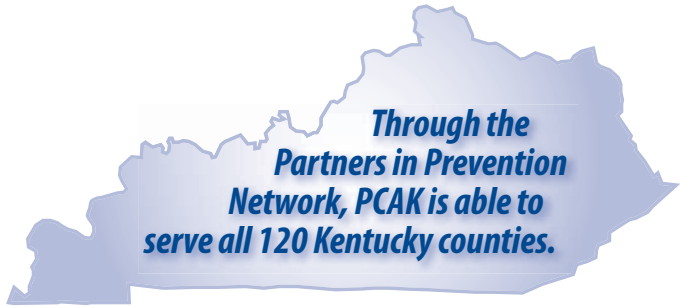
- ▶ **Partners in Prevention:** Links individuals, volunteer groups, agencies and prevention voices throughout the state to initiate change towards keeping Kentucky's children safe.
- ▶ **Self-help parent education and support groups:** PCAK provides funding to local communities for parent education and programming, and

during the 2008-2009 FY, 16,304 incidents of parent education/self-help services were provided.

- ▶ **Advocacy:** PCAK maintains a network of interested citizens that work towards strengthening policies that effect Kentucky's children and families.
- ▶ **Public Education Campaigns:** PCAK strives to educate and inform all citizens of the Commonwealth regarding prevention programs, the prevalence of child abuse and neglect, and ideas on how to get involved in prevention efforts through campaigns such as "Never Shake a Baby", "Never Leave a Child in a Hot Car" and the Pinwheels for Prevention Campaign. During the 2008-2009 FY, PCAK conducted 195 presentations related to Educational Campaigns.
